Overview

For mobile-only systems, the system must be operational within the construction time period and licensees are required to notify the FCC in the same manner as those with construction/coverage requirements.

eCFR :: 47 CFR 1.6100 -

Any tower or base station as defined in this section, provided that it is existing at the time the relevant application is filed with the State or local government under this section.

Construction Requirements by Service

Construct and place into operation within 12 months of initial license grant date, or if modified under the Second Report and Order (FCC 96-27) on or before August



Construction/Coverage Requirements

To notify the FCC that a construction/coverage requirement was met, you must file the Required Notification application via ULS, no later than 15 days after the

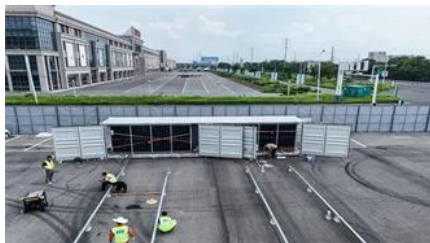
