Iceland has 56 power plants totalling 2,888 MW and 7,953 km of power lines mapped on OpenStreetMap. If multiple sources are listed for a power plant, only the first source is used in this

Electricity sector in Iceland

Iceland's national electrical grid is owned and run by Landsnet and is composed of 3,000 km of transmission lines and approximately 70 substations. Iceland's electricity is produced almost entirely
